Notice of Race

Event: *International Swedish Championship for the International 2,4 mR Class.*
Date: 18-20 August 2017

Organizer: Runns Segelsällskap, Falun

1. Rules

1.1 The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in the Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS). Appendix S, Appendix P and Appendix T will apply.

The sailing instructions will consist of the instructions in RRS Appendix S, Standard Sailing Instructions, and supplementary sailing instructions that will be handed out upon completion of the registration, and posted at the official notice board located at the Club House.

1.2 The Int 2,4 mR Class Rules will apply.

1.3 Boats may be required to display advertising chosen and supplied by the organizing authority. If this rule is broken, World Sailing Regulation 20.9.2 applies.

1.4 The competitor shall follow Swedish Sailing Federations racing license regulation for competitors. This regulation applies from the year the competitor reach the age of 13. Competitors from other countries than Sweden are exempt from this regulation.

1.5 RRS 44.1 is changed so that the Two-Turns Penalty is replaced by the One-Turn Penalty when a boat has broken one or more rules of Part 2.
RRS P2.1 is changed so that the Two-Turns Penalty is replaced by the One-Turn Penalty.

1.6 A boat intending to protest shall hail 'Protest' and display a red flag at the first reasonable opportunity for each. She shall display the flag until she is no longer racing. This changes RRS 61.1 (a) (2).

2. Eligibility requirements

2.1 To be entitled to participate in *Riksidrottsförbundets* championships, each competitor must comply with World Sailing Regulation 19.

2.2 Each participating boat shall be insured with valid third party liability insurance.

2.3 Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See RRS 4, Decision to Race. The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.

2.4 When the water temperature is below +14°C clothing given a good protection against cooling in water shall be worn – wet suit, dry suit or similar.

3. Entries

- 3.1 Entry shall be made not later than Aug 13 and should be done at [IdrottOnline](#) Link available also from the event homepage at www.russ.se. Just state 2,4 and press Sök (search). If you get problems with the online entry please email mikael.lindell@lmstrategi.se
- 3.2 The advance entry shall include the following: Your name, sail number, club, nationality, phone number and e-mail.
- 3.3 The entry fee is 1.400 SEK and shall be paid to BG 5225-0040 or Swish no 1234713848.
At early payment, not later than July 31, the entry fee is **1.100 SEK**.
Make sure to state name and sail number at the payment.
Competitors from other countries than Sweden are allowed to pay cash at registration.
The fee will then be according to entry date.
- 3.4 Meals included in entry fee:
Friday-Sunday Lunch Box (DIY) and After Sail (light meal)
Saturday evening Regatta Dinner (drinks excluded)

4. Registration and measurement checks

- 4.1 Registrations shall be made at the race office not later than Aug 18 09.30.
- 4.2 Measurement certificates and Flotation Certificates shall be presented at registration.
- 4.3 A boat or equipment may be inspected at any time for compliance with the class rules and sailing instructions. On the water, the race- or/and the technical committee can instruct a boat to proceed immediately to a prescribed location for inspection.
- 4.4 Substitution of damaged or lost equipment will not be allowed unless allowed by the class rules or approved by the race committee. Requests for substitution shall be made to the Race committee at the first reasonable opportunity.
- 4.5 Safety inspection and measurement checks of all boats will be made and the result noted on a form. The completed form has to be presented to Race Office in order to accomplish the registration.
- 4.6 Measurement checks: Weight of boats in racing condition, Fore triangle base, Outer point distance.
- 4.7 Sails: Not more than 2 mainsails and 3 foresails may be used during the series. Sails shall have valid measurement certification marks. Sails to be used during the series shall be stamped by the by the organizer. Substitution of damaged or lost sails see 4.4

5. Time schedule

5.2 Nine (9) races are scheduled. Maximum number of races per day is 4.

7. Racing area

7.1 The racing area will be at Korsnäs fjärden, 1 NM East of the harbour area.

8. The course

8.1 Windward-leeward course, offset mark and leeward gate included, will be sailed.

9. Protests and penalty systems

9.1 RRS Appendix P will apply.

9.2 RRS Appendix T will apply

9.3 Decisions of the protest committee will be final as provided in RRS 70.5.

10. Scoring

10.1 The low point scoring system of RRS Appendix A will apply, modified so that when three or fewer races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores.

10.2 3 races are required to be completed to constitute a championship.

11. Prizes

- 11.1 Championship plaquettes and titles may be awarded if six or more boats from at least three different Swedish clubs located in more than one Swedish district have crossed the finish line in one race in the championship.

12. Rules for support persons

- 12.1 Support person shall launch, moor and take up his vessel according to the instructions from the organizer.
- 12.2 Support person shall follow RRS 1, 2 and 55 and not subject a competitor to risk breaking the RRS 41
- 12.3 During a race, a support person should not be closer to a competitor than 50 meters, except when the support person acting under RRS 1.1.
